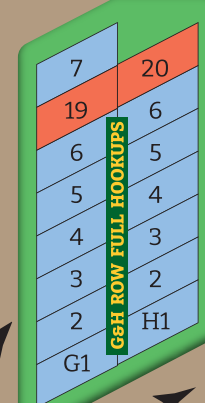
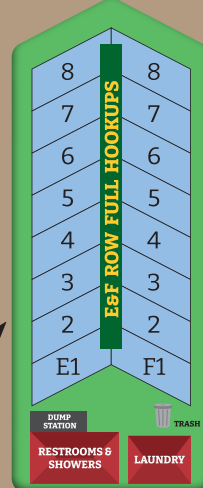
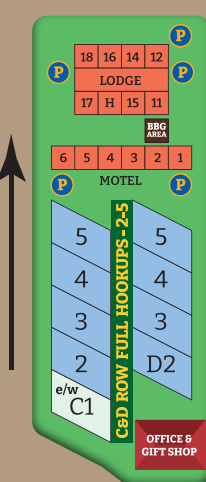

# Welcome to Denali RV Park & Motel!

• **WELCOME TO THE DENALI NATIONAL PARK AREA OF ALASKA.** You're in the middle of some of the most beautiful, unspoiled country in the world. Thank you for staying with us - we're glad you're here! Please take a few minutes to acquaint yourself with the information on both sides of this brochure. The map on the reverse will acquaint you with our park.

• **DENALI VISITOR CENTER AND WILDERNESS ACCESS CENTER.** The Visitor Center (located two miles into the Park) has an informational movie, wildlife exhibit and deli. Get your Park Tour Bus tickets at the Wilderness Access Center (located one mile into the Park). Times and availability vary. Costs are based on how far you decide to go into the park. There are many free things to do in the park besides the bus tours including naturalist walks and evening programs. **Obtain the park newspaper from the Visitor Access Center** to find out specifics. Remember, you can drive your RV to the entry gate (15 miles into the Park on paved road) without restriction. There is a parking lot there. A great view of Denali (weather permitting) can be seen before you reach the gate.

• **INFORMATION, FOOD, TOUR BOOKINGS & TICKETS.** Our courteous and friendly office staff will help you find your way around the area. They can suggest good places to eat or things to do and see off the beaten path. Free coffee is available during gift shop hours along with reasonably priced snacks. Maps and brochures are also available at the gift shop as well as information for rafting, sight seeing flights and ATV tours.

• **GIFT SHOP.** Please visit our gift shop. You'll find many items in our gift shop are unique and aren't available anywhere else. We offer gifts and souvenirs priced for every budget but specialize in high quality merchandise at prices that give you a great value. There's NO sales tax in our area of Alaska.

• **WILDLIFE WATCHING.** Watch for moose, bear, fox, wolves, sheep and other animals in all directions from Denali RV Park and Motel. The mountain and forest behind our park abounds in wildlife. Generally, cool, cloudy days are the best days with dusk and dawn being the high sighting times. In August help yourself to the blueberries that grow behind the park. **Caution. Wild (and potentially dangerous) animals may be encountered any time and any place. Have fun hiking but hike at your own risk. Please know your bear and moose safety procedures.**



## PARK POLICIES & INFORMATION

We want to make your visit extremely pleasant. Please help us make your stay one of your best in Alaska. Our park policies are those which extend common courtesies to your neighbors and insure a pleasant stay for everyone. Please let us know how we can help you.

- **CHECK OUT TIME IS 11 A.M and 10A.M. for rooms.**
- **QUIET HOURS:** 10 P.M. to 7 A.M.
- **PETS:** We like pets too, but they must be kept quiet, and on a leash when in the RV park.
- **PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET.**
- **TRASH:** Please bag and tie your trash before putting it in the nearest trash container. Critters small and large can smell open trash for a country mile - not to mention people!
- **FIRES:** No open fires permitted. Gas or charcoal grills only.
- **NO FIREWORKS OR FIREARMS.**

- **SPEED LIMIT: 5 mph.** The last thing anybody wants on vacation is an injury, so please be careful.
- **NO WASHING OF VEHICLES OR CHANGING OIL:** Our water system and waste system are not designed to handle either. The environment is just too fragile and we are too remote to provide these services. No washing of dishes or utensils in the rest rooms or at outside faucets.
- **MISCELLANEOUS:** Please accompany children under 8 years old to all facilities. Parents are responsible for the actions and safety of their children at all times. **No bike riding in RV park, please.**

## OFFICE AND GIFT STORE HOURS: POSTED ON OFFICE DOOR REST ROOMS AND SHOWERS AVAILABLE 24 HOURS

- **SHOWERS & REST ROOMS:** Our showers and rest rooms are busiest from 7 a.m. to 10 a.m. and from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. If you can schedule your use of them in off hours it will mean less or no wait times. Showers require a token that is for sale in the office. One token lasts 6 minutes.
- **LAUNDRY:** Our Laundry is open during office hours.
- **IN CASE OF EMERGENCY:** Office staff is available for assistance during office hours. After hours EMERGENCY NUMBERS are listed by the office door. **911 is available in this area.**
